

Physics scholarships - applications open

Physics scholarships applications are now open. In order to help recruit physics teachers we encourage you to promote the £28,000, tax-free physics teacher training scholarship to your candidates.

The scheme is aimed at high-quality physicists who have (or are predicted to achieve) at least a 2:1 in a physics or physics-related degree. Candidates must have secured a DfE-allocated ITT training place that will result in QTS by September 2019. Candidates with (or predicted to achieve) a 2:2 degree may be considered if they can demonstrate significant subject knowledge.
